Praises | Chapter 31. Titles and dates unreliable e.g. 'Christians of All Sorts'; mentions title 'Ecclesiastical Art' 1873 - can anyone corroborate? Pop. of Lew Trenchard (1910) 266; nett income £117; 'Daily, daily, Sing to Jesus' sung by 2 Ugandan boys while slowly burned to death after torture and dismemberment at time of Bp. Hannington's murder. OCS written 1865 - published in Church Times with 6 verses; A&M 1904 ed. 'we are not divided' = 'though divisions harass'; recommended for Confirmation and Church Festivals. |
| POPULAR HYMNS and their writers | Norman Mable Independent Press Dec. 1951 (2nd rev.ed). (1st ed. Oct. 1945) | Onward, Christian Soldiers Now The Day Is Over Through The Night Of Doubt | Section of 2 pages. Day before Whitsunday 1865 wrote fresh words to Haydn's tune 'sitting up far into the night'; now sung to Sullivan's tune St. Gertrude. Lew Trenchard said to be in North Devon. |
| A HYMN COMPANION Insight into 300 Christian hymns | Frank Colquhoun Hodder 1985 | Through The Night Of Doubt Onward, Christian Soldiers | Danish original by Prof. Gerhard Ingemann, also author of historical romances and poems. Improves version A&M 1875. Current tune 'Marching' written 1915 by Martin Shaw. Quotes SBG - source to be established. |
| HYMNS WE LOVE Stories of the 100 most popular humns | Arthur Temple Lutterworth 1954 (2nd imp.1958) | Onward, Christian Soldiers Now The Day Is Over | Describes Horbury Brig night school Chosen by Churchill for church parade on battleship Prince of Wales off Newfoundland Aug.10 1941 (signing of the Atlantic Charter) and referred to in his subsequent speech. |
